



Privacy Statement-

PC Guy has created this privacy statement in order to demonstrate our firm commitment to privacy issues. The following discloses the information gathering and dissemination practices for PC Guy.

At PC Guy, we are very committed to your privacy, so here is our PRIVACY PROMISE TO YOU: PC Guy will never sell, exchange, or release any of your individual personal information to a third party without your express permission.

Information we may collect:

Occasionally, we may conduct online surveys or run a contest for promotional purposes, during which, we may ask users for contact information (like email addresses) and demographic information (like zip code, age, or income level). We use contact data to send consumers information about our company and, of course, to notify people if they win the contest.

We understand, though, that you may want to participate in these surveys or contests but may not want us to send you email. Accordingly, as part of these surveys or contests, we will always give you the option of declining to receive information from PC Guy. Hey, if you don't want to receive email, just let us know, and we won't send it. It is as simple as that. [Of course, we will notify you if you win the contest.]

Like other web sites, your IP number is visible to us when you visit our web site. What is an IP address, you may ask? It is a number automatically assigned to your computer whenever you're connected the Internet. Your IP number is visible to most of the websites that you visit. Don't worry, though, at PC Guy, we only use IP numbers to help diagnose problems with our servers, to administer our Web site. Other sites may use your IP number for marketing purposes. We don't.

From time to time, we may share with third parties aggregate information-- such as, how many of our users are men, or how many PC Guy consumers search on Internet-related topics. Such information will not contain any personal identifying information.

Cookies

Like many sites, PC Guy uses cookies. Cookies are data files that are stored on your computer. They contain identification information that enables us to see how our users are interacting with our site and how frequently they are returning. Cookies do not contain any personally identifiable information.

We use cookies for the benefit of our users. Cookies let us know if we have repeat visitors (a strong indication of happy

consumers) and if we are delivering a quality product to our consumers. We also use cookies to identify which sites our repeat visitors are coming from, so that we can place more of our online advertising on these sites. Essentially, it is an anonymous way to survey how we are doing and to look for other consumers who we think will like our site.

If you do not want to accept cookies from PC Guy or other sites, your browser software should allow you to not accept cookies. Look in the Preferences (Netscape) or Internet Options (Microsoft Internet Explorer) feature to do this.

Links to other web sites

PC Guy contains many links to other sites. PC Guy is not responsible for the privacy practices or the content of such Web sites. PC Guy does not share any of the individual personal information you provide PC Guy with the sites to which PC Guy links, although PC Guy may share aggregate data with such sites (such as how many people use our site). This includes other third party sites on the Internet for which PC Guy provides search services.
